

PERFECTLY FORMED



Carpenter Andy Pieri and his wife Suzanne Wardley bought two adjoined flats in Enfield 12 years ago with the intention of knocking them into one home. However, after taking down nearly all the internal walls in one of the flats, the couple decided the space was ample and abandoned the conversion.

Although the kitchen is compact, it is surprisingly well equipped, boasting a range

cooker and plenty of storage. "We were torn between an ultra-modern design in stainless steel or something more classic," says Andy. "Taking the latter option paid off – it still looks current a decade after I made it."

At the centre of the scheme is a circular island unit that Andy created by joining various salvaged bed legs. "They are Japanese oak, so are very solid," says Andy. "I added an end-grain chopping board effect using yacht

rigging round the perimeter, which helps hold everything in place."

The collection of stools has similarly unexpected origins. An old surgeon's stool was bought at a car boot sale for just £3, a friend donated another and two are from Ikea. "They are all comfortable and Suzanne and I spend a lot of time here doing paperwork, reading the papers and eating our meals. It is small but very practical," says Andy.
